Directions:

From Rt. 80/220: Take Bellefonte exit (I-99/Route 220). Follow I-99 to Mt. Nittany Expressway (322W). Take the right hand ramp (past Toftrees exit is Gray's Woods/Philipsburg. Bear right and continue on the Philipsburg ramp. Turn left on 550 (Uni-Mart on left side) And travel 6.1 miles. Stable is on right.

From Rt 220 (Altoona/Tyrone area): Follow 220 to stop light in Port Matilda heading toward State College. Make a right turn at light go over the hill (approx. 1+ miles) to Centennial. Make a right turn at the Y, farm on the right.

HORSE SHOW DIVISIONS (*Colonial Classic) :

Beginner Rider Equitation*: Open to riders of any age who are beginners. Two classes over fences (2' in height) & at least one flat class. \$60.00 division.

1. Beginner Rider Walk Trot
2. Beginner Rider Walk Trot Canter
3. Beginner Rider O/F
4. Beginner Rider O/F

Mini Stirrup: A walk trot division for those 10 & under as of 12/1/2018. May Cross-enter Short Stirrup W-T classes only. An Equitation, Pleasure & Under Saddle offered.

5. Mini Stirrup W-T Equitation Each individual show may run this as they would like - 1 round over fences. For judging: handicap is +6 points for 2' horses; +3 points for 2'6" and 3 foot to be judged straight across the board.
6. Mini Stirrup W-T Pleasure
7. Mini Stirrup W-T Under Saddle

Short-Stirrup: Open to riders 10 and under as of 12/1/2018. Three classes to be offered with at least 1 class O/F. May cross enter into classes with fence height not to exceed 2'. Year -end sponsor is Centre Equine Practice.

Special Hunter*: Open to horses and ponies. All fences 2'6". Cannot cross-enter into any 3'6" divisions. Two classes O/F & a flat class.

Adult Amateur Hunter*: Open to adult riders. Fences not to exceed 3' in height. See Zone II specs. Two classes over fences & a flat class. All those showing must Possess an Amateur card. Year-end sponsor is State College Veterinary Hospital /Dr. Kathleen Kocher.

Children's Hunter*: Open to horses and ponies ridden by a junior rider (under 18 as of 12/1/18). Fence heights not to exceed 2' for sm. and med. ponies; 2'6" large ponies; 3' for horses. If entries warrant, the division may be split. Two classes over fences and a flat class. Year-end sponsor is Jodon's Stable.

RULES AND REGULATIONS:

1. Jodon's Stable will not be responsible for any loss or any accident/loss/damages to any animal, exhibitor, spectator, groom, owner or equipment before/after/during or after the day of the show.
2. The judges' decision is final.
3. Stake classes will pay 20-15-10-5% this year. There must be 3 to fill a class/div.
4. USEF approved headgear must be worn in all classes and during all schooling. Sessions by all exhibitors, trainers or coaches before and during the horse show.
5. There is a \$20.00 EMT grounds fee/ per family (except Lead Line).
6. Entry fees: \$50.00 division or \$18 individually.
7. USEF rules apply and horse show management reserves the right to cancel or combine classes as entries warrant. **Negative coggins and EHV-1 must be provided with each entry.**
