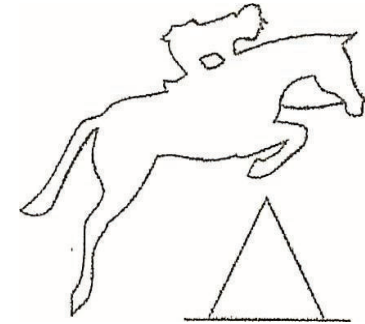

RULES AND REGULATIONS

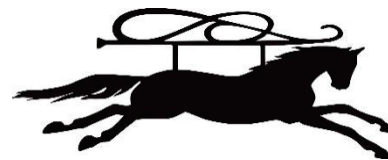
1. Summer Breeze Stables will not be responsible for any loss or any injury to any animal, exhibitor, or owner on the premises the day of the show.
2. The judge's decision is final.
3. Stake classes will pay \$20, \$15, \$10, and \$5. All divisions must have minimum of six entries for payback.
4. USEF approved headgear must be worn in all classes and during all schooling sessions by all exhibitors, trainers, coaches before and during the horse show.
5. There is a \$25.00 EMT/grounds fee per rider (except for Lead Line).
6. Entry fees are \$25.00 for all classes.
7. USEF rules apply.
8. Horse show management reserves the right to cancel or combine classes as entries warranted.
9. Negative Coggins Test Required within 12 months

Horse Show Divisions

Lead Line: Open to riders 7 years and under. Children may cross enter into the Mini Stirrup Division.

- Walk on the Lead Line
- Lead Line walk and trot
- Lead Line off the line

Beginner Rider Equitation: Open to riders of any age who are considered beginners. Two classes over fences (2' in height) and at least one flat class. Division may be split by age if entries warrant.

- Beginner Rider Walk Trot
- Beginner Rider Walk Trot Canter
- Beginner Rider Over Fences (2 classes)

Mini-Stirrup: A walk/trot division for those 10 and under as of 12/1 of the previous year. May cross enter Short Stirrup W/T class only.

- Mini Stirrup Walk Trot Equitation
- Mini Stirrup Walk Trot Pleasure
- Mini Stirrup Walk Trot Under Saddle

Short Stirrup Equitation: Open to riders 10 years and under as of 12/1 of the previous year. May cross enter into classes with fence heights not to exceed 2'.

- Short Stirrup Walk Trot
- Short Stirrup Walk Trot Canter
- Short Stirrup Over Cross Rails (2 classes)

Long Stirrup Equitation: A division offering WT, WTC and cross rails (not to exceed 2'). This division is for riders who are non-professionals and young horses to get started with no restrictions on previous wins.

Note: Colonial Classic will take adults only for this division.

All Classes in the Outside Ring

Low Adult/Low Children's Hunter: Division may be split by horses & ponies if entries warrant. Cannot cross-enter into Adult or Children's Hunter or Equitation divisions. Fences to be: 2' ponies; 2'6" horses.

- Pre-Adult/Pre-Children's Over Fences (2 classes)
- Pre-Adult/Pre-Children's Hunter Stake
- Pre-Adult/Pre-Children's Hunter Under Saddle

Adult and Children's Equitation: to be judged with the same specifications as Zone II Adult and Children's Hunter.

- Adult Equitation Over Fences
- Adult Equitation on the Flat
- Children's Equitation Over Fences
- Children's Equitation on the Flat

Adult Amateur Hunter: Open to adults with amateur status.. Fences no to exceed 3 feet. All those showing must possess an Amateur Card.

- Adult Amateur Over Fences (2 classes)
- Adult Amateur Stake
- Adult Amateur Under Saddle

Children's Hunter: Open to horses and ponies ridden by a junior rider (under 18 as of 12/1 of previous year). Fence heights not to exceed 2' for small and medium ponies; 2'6" large ponies; and 3' for horses. If entries warrant, the division may be split.

- Children's Hunter Over Fences (2 classes)
- Children's Hunter Stake
- Children's Hunter Under Saddle

Mature Rider: Open to riders 18 and older as of 12/1 of previous year who are considered beginners. Fences at 2'.

Lesson Horse: Horse/Pony will split if entries warrant.
 Lesson Horse Walk Trot
 Lesson Horse Walk, Trot, Canter
 Lesson Horse Over Fences (2 classes)

Hunter Pleasure: Open to horses and ponies showing under hunt seat tack. May cross enter into other hunter divisions.
 Bridle Path Hack
 Road Hack
 Hunter Pleasure Stake

Modified Hunter: For green horses and/or green riders. Two divisions split into Pro and Non-Pro. All fences 2'.
 Modified Hunter Over Fences (2 classes)
 Modified Hunter Stake
 Modified Hunter Under Saddle

TIP Division: (TB Incentive Program)
 Open to all thoroughbred horses whether or not they are signed up for TIP. All fences 2'6".
 TIP Hunter Over Fences (2 classes)
 TIP Hunter Stake
 TIP Hunter Under Saddle

Special Hunter: Open to horses and ponies. All fences 2'6". Cannot cross-enter into any 3 '6" divisions.
